

SIGNING OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
- THE CHRISTIAN FOUNDATION FOR THE BLIND IN THAILAND AND THE
EDUCATION SOCIETY OF SINGAPORE
AND BETWEEN
- SMART ASSISTIVE INNOVATION TECHNOLOGIES AND ST.URIEL EDUCATION

BANGKOK and SINGAPORE – December 15, 2021

The Christian Foundation for the Blind in Thailand (CFBT), represented by President Mr.Pongsak Kasemsuvan, Smart Assistive Innovation Technologies (SAINT), represented by Chairman Mr. Kosol Somchinda, and Education Society of Singapore (ESS) and St. Uriel Education (STU), represented by ESS President/STU Director Mr. Marcus Lim, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Wednesday, December 1, 2021.

The MOUs are agreements on a long-term joint initiative known as The Good Shepherd Project, which focuses on establishing and promoting Braille education, blind culture, and linking communities-of-service to communities-in-need in Thailand, Singapore and throughout the world. As part of the effort to establish inclusion and fairness in society, the initiative will be made available to both the visually impaired and the sighted people.

The agreement, in the form of MOU between CFBT and ESS, formalizes the focus on developing Thai Braille on Taptilo and Braille-based activities through partnerships, facilitating connections for communities-of-service and communities-in-need outreach to Thai and global society.

Furthermore, the agreement between SAINT and St. Uriel aims to promote Taptilo, as well as design, develop, and integrate the "Good Shepherd" Platform, which provides social, educational, and career activities for the visually impaired, as well as sell "Good Shepherd" Braille-based activities and lessons in Thailand and around the world. Both parties shall also develop and promote "blind culture" workshops and tours.
